CATARACT PROCEDURE – DR.GROSSMAN

Patient is scheduled for procedure on _____.

◆ *A nurse from our facility will contact you with the arrival time prior to your procedure.*

❖ PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS

ON THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE, PATIENT MAY HAVE CLEAR LIQUIDS (SUCH AS JELLO, BROTH, TEA, BLACK COFFEE), NO DAIRY PRODUCTS, FROM 12 MIDNIGHT UP TO 4 HOURS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED ARRIVAL TIME.

Take blood pressure, heart medication, thyroid medication, and/or seizure medication with a small amount of water like normal.

Otherwise do not take any medication until after the procedure.

If patient uses an inhaler(s), please bring it on the day of the procedure.

Bring list of medication taken on a regular basis (prescription, over the counter, and/or vitamins).

Wear loose, comfortable clothes.

Bring glasses/contacts and their case.

Wear hearing aid and/or dentures; if used.

❖ PLEASE LEAVE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AT HOME

All jewelry (including rings, watches, body piercing accessories, etc.)

Cash, wallet, purse, or any other personal belongings.

❖ PATIENT MUST HAVE

A responsible adult driver who must stay at the facility while the patient is in the procedure.

A responsible adult must be with the patient at least 24 hours after discharge.
